

# Contemporary Canadian Art Quilts From Fine Craft to Fine Art

Joan Hug-Valeriotte is curating a multimedia art quilt show at Kitchener City Hall, in the Berlin Tower Artspace, 200 King St. W. Kitchener, Ontario, from April 8<sup>th</sup> to May 30<sup>th</sup>, 2017. Opposite ground floor payment counter beside the Rotunda.

The “virtual” component of the show is a continuous video display of over 100 art quilt photos compiled in a dynamic video collage encompassing several universal themes. The fibre artists come from across Canada and their work will be displayed over a 5 foot square array of twenty MicroTiles (LED screens). A selection of “real” art quilts will also be on display in the Artspace .
